SUBJECT TO CHANGE: Program availability, prices and lesson formats are subject to change.

HELMET POLICY: Ski & Snowboard Schools of Aspen/Snowmass recommend that all participants wear a helmet. Helmets are required for all children ages 17 & under participating in lessons and for all ages during lessons in the terrain park or halfpipe.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Lessons with reservations must be cancelled at least 48 hours in advance of reservation date. Reservations cancelled within the 48 hour time allowance will be charged the full lesson window rate.

LATE ARRIVALS: We may not be able to accommodate late arrivals for group lessons.

GROUP LESSON MEETING TIME: Plan to arrive at your lesson meeting area ready to go 15 minutes prior to start time. Allow at least an extra hour if you are renting equipment. If time allows, pick up your rentals the evening before your lesson. Parents with children should plan on arriving early the first day of the lesson, or the afternoon before, to fill out required paperwork.

- Drink plenty of water a few days before you arrive and remember to continue to drink water while you are here.
- Apply a strong UVA/UVB sunscreen to protect the skin from high altitude rays. Remember to re-apply throughout the day even on cloudy days.
- Make sure the family eats a good breakfast before hitting the slopes. A well-fed body has the energy to stay warm and enjoy a full day on the snow.
- Layering your clothing can help keep you warm on a brisk day, or if you get too hot, it allows you to shed one layer to stay comfortable.

ADAPTIVE PROGRAMS

Challenge Aspen – Founded as an adaptive ski program in 1995, Challenge Aspen has evolved into a year-round program, offering anyone with a disability access to a variety of sports, recreational and cultural activities. In the winter, the program offers all levels of recreational skiing and snowboarding instruction for individuals ages 4 and up who have a physical or cognitive disability. Participants receive specialized private instruction through Challenge Aspen's PSIA-certified adaptive instructors, and adaptive equipment is provided to accommodate all needs.
