NEW NON-STOP FLIGHTS TO ASPEN SNOWMASS THIS WINTER

American Airlines expands service to Aspen Snowmass Pitkin County Airport with a total of five daily flights through January 4th, 2016 and four daily flights continuing through April 4th, 2016. In addition, American is planning to expand service from Dallas/Fort Worth with a third daily non-stop flight over the holidays. Delta Airlines has expanded Minneapolis/St. Paul nonstop service to 5x per week from December 19th to January 4th and from 2x per week (Saturdays plus Wednesdays as well) from February 13th to March 26th.
