TRAVELER TIPS

- » Imagine gate-to-gondola in half an hour. Snowmass is only 6 miles from Aspen Snowmass' airport (ASE), where Snowmass connects to the world via non-stop flights from Atlanta, Chicago, Dallas, Denver, Houston, Los Angeles, Minneapolis, Salt Lake City and San Francisco.
- » Feel free to travel light. Over 20 shops and outfitters will set you up with rental gear – from boots and skis to apparel and accessories – which you can grab slopeside or have delivered right to your door.
- » You won't need a car. Most lodging properties offer airport transportation, and free shuttles run frequently around Snowmass Village and to Aspen.
- » The two main dining and shopping areas, Base Village and the Snowmass Mall, are connected by a free Sky Cab Gondola that runs morning to night.
- » Plan time on your itinerary for off-piste adventures such as cross-country skiing, dogsledding, showshoeing, a day at the Snowmass Recreation Center, and much more.
