When It Comes to the Beauty of Snowmass, Seeing is Believing



Snowmass Village, Colo., (October 2018) – Nothing compares with the scenic beauty of Snowmass. From Snowmass Village (8,606 feet), views stretch in all directions, including uphill to where 96 trails on 3,332 acres of terrain await. From the mountain (12,510 feet at the top of The Cirque), camera-ready views of snow-shrouded peaks and sprawling valleys stretch as far as the eye can see.

Head up the Elk Camp Chair to check out the renowned Maroon Bells and the Elk Mountain Range.

Take the Cirque lift to the highest point on the mountain, which offers incredible views of the Roaring Fork Valley from Mt. Sopris to the Continental Divide.

Ski or ride into Sam's Smokehouse. From its deck, Mount Daly looks close enough to touch.

From the top of the Big Burn, a run down Sneaky's comes with panoramic views of Garret's and Capitol Peak.

The view of Zeigler Reservoir hasn't changed much in 120,000 years since mastodons, sloths, mammoths and more called it home. A cruise down Dawdler will inspire imagination and awe.
