# VENUES

Here are just a few of our favorite wedding venues within Snowmass Village – alongside some helpful ideas of both affordable and luxurious places to stay, exciting and comforting places to eat and, of course, fun, relaxing, and exhilarating things to do to keep you and your guests entertained.

## **VICEROY SNOWMASS**

The Viceroy Snowmass offers both indoor and outdoor event space and is as versatile as can be. It's perfect for small and intimate gatherings of up to 10 guests – great for a low-key, pandemic-friendly wedding, large-scale wedding parties for up to 300 guests, and everything in-between! Wedding pictures of the Snowmass Village and the Rocky Mountains in the background don't get much more romantic.

## **LIMELIGHT HOTEL SNOWMASS**

Couples who dream of an outdoor mountainside wedding with unrivaled valley and forest views should look no further than the Limelight Hotel Snowmass. With seasonal availability between June to mid-October, the bride and groom can exchange their vows on the Snowmass Wedding Terrace, which has amphitheater seating for up to 146 guests, before heading to the Limelight Hotel Snowmass for the reception.







### **MCCABE RANCH**

The McCabe Ranch is a 20-minute drive from Snowmass Village, and provides a romantic, rustic, and unforgettable vibe for weddings of all sizes. Couples can choose to hold their ceremony on one of the perfectly manicured polo fields, Tipi Village, or even the historic Camp Hale Field House. ### **ELK CAMP**

With year-round availability, Elk Camp is a great choice for lovers of mountains and architecture and is easily reached by a 12-minute scenic gondola ride. The views of Elk Camp and the Hanging Valley Wall can be seen from the venue, and it's perfect for couples wanting something a little different. If

your wedding is on the larger side, Elk Camp is a great choice. It is a one-of-a-kind venue that can accommodate 300 guests and offers additional seating in the adjacent outdoor patio. Guests can also be seated in the separate bar area, which comes complete with a cozy fireplace that looks and feels wonderful in the colder months.



### **T-LAZY-7**

T-Lazy-7 is an outstanding setting for both intimate and large-scale weddings, thanks to its 400-guest capacity and rustic ranch setting. For example, The Daly Room, which got its name because of its spectacular views of Snowmass' iconic Mt. Daly, is a 1,664-square-foot banquet hall that can host 100 dinner guests.
