Summer 2026 Trial Program | June 21 – September 6

PERMITTED TRAILS

Class 1 e-bikes are allowed **ONLY** on these trails:

Trail	Type	Length
Discovery	Uphill	2.4 mi
Village Bound	Downhill	1.9 mi
Luge	Downhill	0.9 mi
Fanny Hill	Downhill	0.5 mi
Thornton Road	Road	1.1 mi
Dawdler Road	Road	1.1 mi

RULES & ETIQUETTE

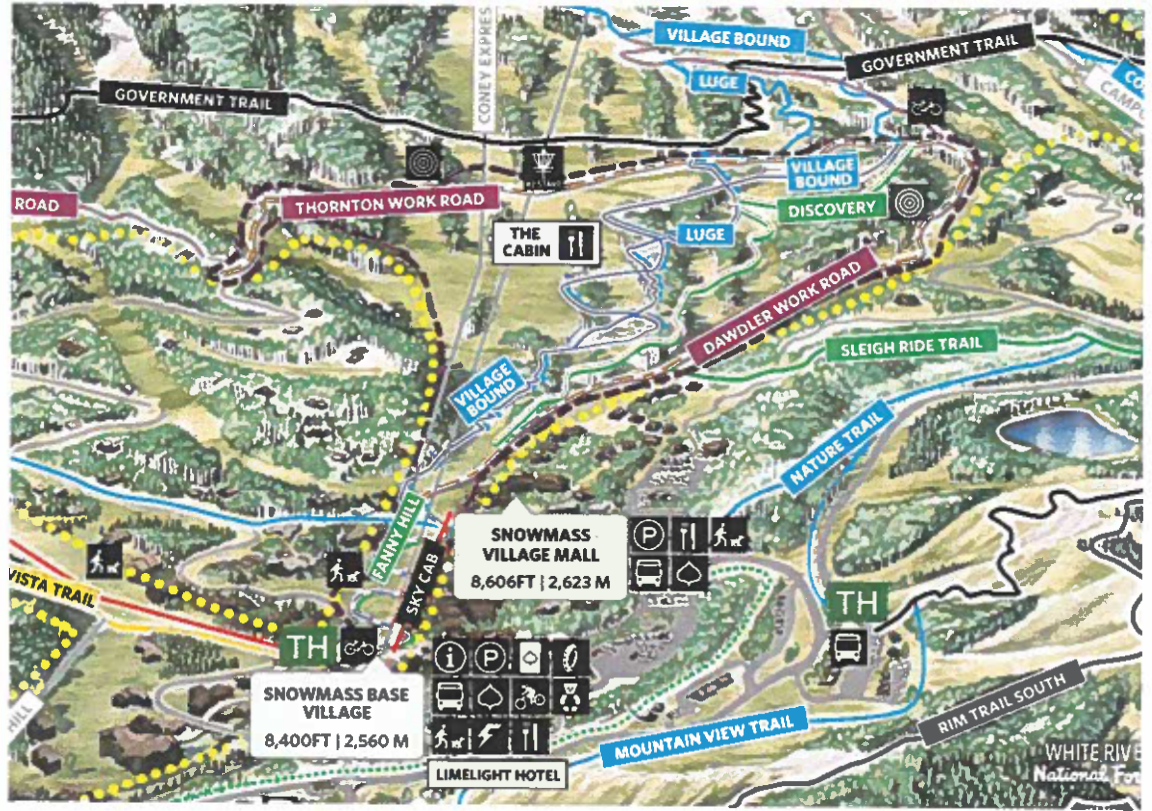
- Class 1 e-bikes only (pedal-assist, max 20 mph)
- Stay on designated e-bike trails only
- Yield to hikers and traditional mountain bikers
- No e-bikes on Government Trail
- Follow all posted directional and yield signage
- Avoid wet or muddy trails to prevent erosion
- Wear a helmet at all times
- Keep audio low enough to hear other users and wildlife
- Be cautious of construction vehicles on work roads

ENFORCEMENT

\$100 fine for first offense. Snowmass Bike Patrol monitors daily. Game cameras are in use along the trail perimeter.

Report violations: (970) 923-0560

E-Bike use is permitted on trail segments within the purple hatched boundary.



ABOUT THIS TRIAL PROGRAM

This is a trial program approved by the Town of Snowmass Village. E-bike access is limited to ASC-owned land and the designated trails in this guide. The program will be evaluated at the end of the 2026 season based on trail usage data and guest feedback.
